## A LOCAL JUNCTION

Lyngdal is a geographical and communicative junction in the western region of Agder. E 39 and RV 43 pass through the town and connect east and west, south and north more than any other municipality in the region. Around 50 000 people can reach Lyngdal within 40-45 minutes. The travelling distance is an hour to Kristiansand and two and a half hour to Stavanger.

### Train

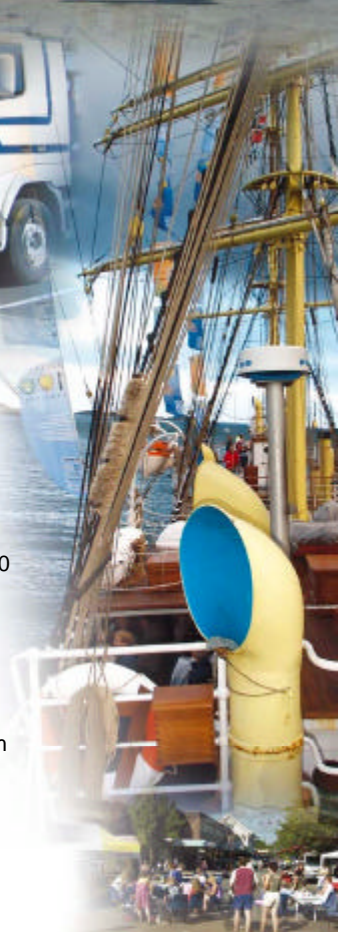
Railway connection from Snartemo station, about 30 minutes drive from Lyngdal. ([www.nsb.no](http://www.nsb.no))
